Create a technical résumé for yourself. If you already have a résumé, use that as a starting point, and modify it using to the guidelines provided by the career center and our discussion of technical résumé tips. The résumé should have, at a minimum, the following sections:

- 1. Contact information
- 2. Education
- 3. Technical Skills (include programming languages and proficiency level in each language in this part of the résumé.)

You may also have the following optional sections if you have relevant information that should be included in them.

- 4. Work Experience
- 5. Service: include professional, religious and Greek organizations of which you are a member, any offices held in these organizations, volunteer activities, etc. in this section
- 6. Publications
- 7. Research Experience

What to turn in: Print out a hard copy of your résumé to turn in.
